Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ENERGY PRODUCTION CORPORATION** for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters in the **19000' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir G**, in the Morganza Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate, such unit to be designated 19000 TUSC RG SUA;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate a unit well for the proposed unit;

4. To designate Energy Production Corporation as the unit operator for the proposed unit;
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the 19,000' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir G, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing, if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The 19,000' Tuscaloosa Sand in the Morganza Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1102-B, effective September 19, 1995, and was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1102-B-7, effective June 4, 2002.




