Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Toce Energy L.L.C. to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Cockfield Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lottie Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Cockfield Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lottie Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for this sand and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created.
4. To provide that any well drilled outside of the Cockfield Sand, Reservoir A, shall be in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the Reservoir by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The Cockfield Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lottie Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,196' and 10,247' (electrical log measurements) in the Texaco - Lottie Land & Dev. No. 3 Well (SN 039958), located in Section 25, Township 6 South, Range 8 East, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the Lottie Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Lottie Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.



A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Toce Energy L.L.C., in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.


