Aspect Energy, L.L.C., ("Applicant") hereby makes application to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Cris I Zone, Reservoir C, in the Northwest Kenilworth Field, St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Cris I Zone, Reservoir C, in the Northwest Kenilworth Field, shall comply with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoirs by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to this application.

The Cris I Zone is defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 8,327 feet and 10,090 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Atlantic Richfield – Joseph Meraux No. 1 Well (WSN 139449), located in Section 4, Township 13 South, Range 13 East, St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana.

A timely request for the pre-application conference tentatively scheduled for July 18, 2005 was not received; therefore the pre-application conference will not be held.



NOTE: ALL UNIT BOUNDARIES ARE GEOGRAPHIC.


