Aspect Energy, L.L.C., ("Applicant") hereby makes application to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Cristellaria I Zone, Reservoirs A & B, in the Reggio Field, St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
2. To create single drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Cristellaria I Zone, Reservoirs A & B, in the Reggio Field, shall comply with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoirs by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to this application.

The Cristellaria I Zone is defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 9,200 feet and 11,710 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Tschirn – Hattier No. 1 Well (WSN 77232), located in Section 96, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana.

The Pre-Hearing Conference was held as scheduled in the Pre-Application Notice dated June 24, 2005 on Friday, July 5, 2005. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of those parties in attendance. Doffie Ross, on behalf of the Applicant presented the geological, engineering or other basis for the proposed units. After some discussion concerning a request to modify the Applicant's unit proposal the meeting was adjourned with no changes or modifications being made. It is unknown at this time whether there will be opposition to the Applicant's proposal.

All pertinent data relating to the subject application is available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Blvd., Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002. The Applicant will provide for posting a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and a copy of the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected by this application and will cause the publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of the Reggio Field. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties, Interested Parties and Pre-Hearing Conference Attendees all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof, a plat outlining the proposed units and a list of names and addresses of the Interested Parties, Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Pre-Hearing Conference Attendees to whom this notice is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of Parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The aforementioned list is available upon request to any Interested Party. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is enclosed herewith on behalf of the Applicant a check made payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.


