5800' Zone, Reservoir A
Crowley Field
Acadia Parish, Louisiana

Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CAMEX OPERATING COMPANY** (Applicant") for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to THE 5800' Zone, Reservoir A in Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 46 acres for the exploration for and the production of gas and condensate from the 5800' Zone, Reservoir A in Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated 5800' RA SU A, as shown on the attached plat.
1. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral interests and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
2. To designate Camex Operating Company as the operator for the proposed 5800' RA SU A.
3. To designate the Camex Operating Company - Florence Hebert No. 1 well as the unit well for the proposed 5800' RA SU A.
4. To provide that future wells drilled inside the 5800' RA SU A shall be exempt from the provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E

5. To provide for future reclassification of the reservoir by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir so warrant and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 5800' ZONE, RESERVOIR A in Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the measured depths of 5,677 feet and 5,728 feet electrical log measurements (5,652 feet and 5,698 feet TVD) in the Camex Operating Company - Florence Hebert No. 1 well, located in section 22, Township 10 South - Range 1 East, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held on Monday, November 28 at the offices of Camex Operating Company at 103 Exchange Place, Lafayette, Louisiana. The undersigned opened the conference and explained the basis for the proposal being offered on behalf of Camex. Mr. James Hardwick, representing the Hoffpauir Interest presented a unit of 18 acres +/-, which utilized the same faulting as the applicant but a different structural interpretation. A compromise could not be reached and therefore the unit attached is being requested under applicable provisions of the Revised Rules of Procedure.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to who notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of the unit plat is enclosed herewith, and a copy of this letter and the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties, as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for POSTING of a copy of the legal notice of the hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause the LEGAL NOTICE to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of the Crowley Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice.

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Also enclosed is a check, in the amount of \$ 755.00, payable to the Louisiana Office of Conservation, which represents the required hearing fee.
