

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2006**, upon the application of **RIMCO PRODUCTION COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Scott Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir A, said unit designated NS RA SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 14,829 feet and 15,260 feet, electrical log measurements, (14,625 feet and 15,056 feet TVD), in the Noble Energy, Inc.-A.E. Duhon et al No.1 Well, located in Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
