Application is hereby made on behalf of SAMSON CONTOUR ENERGY E & P, LLC., for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidenced relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the Marginulina Texana Sand, Reservoir C, in the Perry Point Field, Acadia and Lafayette Parishes, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit for the Marg Tex Sand for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate, such unit to be designated MT RC SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To designate Samson Contour Energy E & P, LLC., as operator of the proposed unit.
4. To designate a unit well for the proposed unit.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Marg Tex Sand in Perry Point Field should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing, if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Marg Tex Sand, in the Perry Point Field, Acadia and Lafayette Parishes, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No.448-K, effective July 10, 1973. It is hereby further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 12,870 feet and 13,065 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Samson Contour Energy E & P, LLC - Plattsmier-Hulin No. 1 Well, located in Section 21, Township 10 South, Range 2 East, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

A pre-application conference was held on Friday, August 25, 2006, at the Petroleum Club of Lafayette, Louisiana, at 10:00 a.m. Mr. Frank Harrison, representing the applicant, introduced the meeting and gave the reasons for holding such conferences. He then presented exhibits relative to the applicant's plan of unitization. Mr. Harrison discussed the original definition, the proposed unit well, the structure map and fault plane map

supporting the applicants proposed unit. He also noted that the revenues for the well, which is presently producing, is being escrowed, pending issuance of an Order for the unit. He then asked if there were any questions regarding the proposal and there were none.

Mr. Bill Robbins then presented a plan which was very similar to the applicant's proposed unit but which included some acreage on the southeast side of the unit. He then answered questions from those at the conference.

Mr. David Sturlese, representing the Mauboules interests, presented a plan which added acreage on the south side of the unit. His plan would add approximately 45 acres to the applicant's unit. He then proceeded to answer several questions from the others attending the conference.

Mr. Jason Talbot, representing the Mineral Board of the State of Louisiana presented a plan which also added acreage to the applicants proposed unit. No questions were asked Mr. Talbot regarding his proposed unit.


Mr. Jim Hardwick, representing Ms. Patty Richard, presented a plan which would add a small amount of acreage to the southwest edge of the applicant's proposed unit.

There being no further presentations, Mr. Harrison closed the meeting indicating that he would be in contact with all the various parties and, if possible, try to reach a plan which would be suitable to all parties.
