Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ANADARKO PETROLEUM CORPORATION** for the calling of public hearings, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, and the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in Dodson Field, Winn Parish, Louisiana:

Hosston Zone, Reservoir A

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Dodson Field, Winn Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit designated HOSS RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Anadarko Petroleum Corporation as operator of the proposed unit.
4. To designate its LA Minerals 36 No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit.
5. To provide that any future substitute and/or alternate unit wells drilled to the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

7. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Dodson Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing formation encountered between the depths of 9,441 feet and 12,930 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Getty Oil Company – Crown Zellerbach 12-8 No. 1 Well, located in Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 3 West, Winn Parish, Louisiana.

Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Dodson Field, Winn Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit designated CV RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.

5. To designate Anadarko Petroleum Corporation as operator of the proposed unit.

6. To designate its LA Minerals 36 No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit.

5. To provide that any future substitute and/or alternate unit wells drilled to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

7. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Dodson Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing formation encountered between the depths of 12,120 feet and 15,195 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Texaco, Inc. – M.B. Allison No. 1 Well, located in Section 10, Township 12 North, Range 4 West, Winn Parish, Louisiana, with the top

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of the Cotton Valley Formation further defined as being at a depth of 12,930 feet (electrical log measurement) in the Getty Oil Company – Crown Zellerbach 12-8 No. 1 Well, located in Section 12, Township 12 North, Range 3 West, Winn Parish, Louisiana.








