Application is hereby made on behalf of Plymouth Resource Group II, Inc. ("Applicant") to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the CAM IV RA SU T, in the Welsh Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to designate and utilize their Farmers Oil Co. Fee No. 11 well (WSN 186796) as a substitute unit well for CAM IV RA SU T at a location in exception to the well spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 679-F as amended by Office of Conservation 679-F-6, effective January 4, 1994.

2. To find that the proposed substitute unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of CAM IV RA SU T which cannot be effectively and efficiently drained by any existing well within the unit.

3. To designate the Applicant as operator of CAM IV RA SU T.

4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to this application.

The Camerina IV Sand was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 679-F, effective December 1, 1964.

All pertinent data relating to the subject application is available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N.

Causeway Blvd., Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002. Any person wishing to inspect such data should call (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the Office of Conservation can be obtained at the expense of the requesting party.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and proposed well location plat in a prominent place in the area of the Welsh Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana. Also, the legal notice will be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation in the vicinity of the Welsh Field.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof, a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties to whom this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The aforementioned list is available upon request to any Interested Party. A diligent effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Parties, Interested Owners, and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is attached hereto a check made payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee on behalf of the Applicant.


