

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2006**, upon the application of **ORACLE OIL, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Sub Pilot Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Angie Field, Washington Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Sub Pilot Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral interest and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Oracle Oil, LLC as the operator for the proposed SUB PILOT RB SUA.
4. To designate the J. Pope No. 1 as the unit well for the proposed SUB PILOT RB SUA.
5. To designate the T. Olga Robbins No. 1 well as an alternate unit well for the SUB PILOT RB SUA.
6. To provide that future wells drilled inside the SUB PILOT RB SUA shall be exempt from the provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
8. To continue in force and effect the provisions of the 254-E Series of Office of Conservation Orders.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Sub Pilot Zone, Reservoir B, is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the measured depths of 9,050 feet and 9,072 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Moshbacher-T. Olga Robbins No. 1 Well, located in Section 52, Township 1 South, Range 14 East, Washington Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
