

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2006**, upon the application of **SAMSON CONTOUR ENERGY E&P, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston A Zone and the Hosston B Zone**, in the Sibley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize applicant to drill, designate and utilize two (2) additional alternate unit wells for HOSS A SUB and HOSS B SUB; one (1) additional alternate unit well for HOSS A SUC and HOSS B SUC; and one (1) additional alternate unit well for HOSS A SUK and HOSS B SUK; at the locations shown on the plats submitted with the application.
2. To approve exceptions to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 148-J, effective February 1, 1972, for any of the proposed wells the location of which, as shown on the plats submitted with the application, is not in compliance with those spacing provisions.
3. To find that each of the proposed alternate unit wells is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston A Zone and the Hosston B Zone underlying the unit on which it is proposed to be drilled which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such unit.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston A and B Zones, were defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 148-J, effective February 1, 1972, and the base of the Hosston B Zone as to HOSS B SUK was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 148-J-242, effective January 6, 2004.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
