TELLUS OPERATING GROUP, L.L.C. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Formation, Reservoir A, in the Antioch Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create six (6) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Haynesville Formation, Reservoir A, such units being shown on the attached plat and being designated HAY RA SUHH through HAY RA SUMM.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed additional units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator of, and unit wells for, the proposed additional units as may be appropriate.
4. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of the Office of Conservation Order No. 344-C series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional units for the Haynesville Formation, Reservoir A.
5. To discuss such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Formation, Reservoir A, in the Antioch Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 344-C, effective March 30, 1983.

Pertinent data concerning this application is available for inspection at the offices of Tellus Operating Group, L.L.C., 602 Crescent Place, Suite 100, Ridgeland, Mississippi 39157. Any

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person wishing to inspect such data should call Mr. Mike Liebert at (601) 898-7444 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.



No request for the pre-application conference was received within ten (10) days of the date of said letter; accordingly, no pre-application conference was held.

A copy of the unit plat (which is identical to the plat attached to the pre-application notice) is enclosed herewith, and a copy of this letter and of the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to each of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plat, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Antioch Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, enclosed herewith is our check payable to the Office of Conservation covering the application fee.


