Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Castex Energy, Inc. for the calling of a public hearing, after 10 days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hollywood Sand, Reservoir B, Sunrise Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, complete and utilize the Castex Energy, Inc. - Michael X. St. Martin et al No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for the HLYWD RB SUA at the location indicated on the attached plat, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 429-G-2, effective July 28, 1981.
2. To find that the proposed substitute unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the unit which cannot be drained by any existing well within such unit.
3. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order 429-G-2 and the unit created thereby.
4. To consider any other matters which may be pertinent to this application.

The Hollywood Sand, Reservoir B, in the Sunrise Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 429-G-2, effective July 28, 1981.

The existing unit well for the HLYWD RB SUA, The Superior Oil Company – Southdown, Inc. No. 9 well has been plugged and abandoned and the applicant is requesting permission to drill, complete and utilize the Castex Energy, Inc. - Michael X. St. Martin et al No. 1 well as a substitute unit well for this unit.

**Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat showing the proposed substitute unit well. There is enclosed a list of names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties who are being forwarded these applications and plats. Such list is being forwarded ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of Interested Owners and Represented Parties, and Interested Parties will be furnished by the undersigned to any party requesting a copy of it. This list includes the names and addresses of all Interested Parties who are known to the applicant, after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.**

**Finally, there is attached hereto a check made out to the Louisiana Office of Conservation in the amount of \$755.00 representing the application fee for this application.**



