LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2006**, upon the application of **WHITING OIL & GAS CORPORATION**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Davis A Sand, Reservoir A and the Davis B Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Lisbon Field, Claiborne and Lincoln Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To create one additional drilling and production unit for the Davis A Sand, Reservoir A and two additional drilling and production units for the Davis B Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation as the unit operator of each of the units so created and their J J Henry Heirs No. 1 Well as the unit well for DAVIS A RA SUE and DAVIS B RA SUE, and their Bean Est No. 1 Well as the unit well for DAVIS B RA SUF each at the location at which they were drilled.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Davis A Sand, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 99-JJ, effective November 16, 1999.

The Davis B Sand, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 99-KK, effective November 16, 1999.
