LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2006**, upon the application of **MANNON WALTERS, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **14,700' Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Simon Pass Field, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the 14,100' Sand Unit as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 610-B, effective October 1, 1962, the 14,300' Sand Unit as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 610, effective October 1, 1962, and the 14,600' Sand Unit as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 610-A, effective October 1, 1962; and simultaneously therewith, to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created.
4. To provide that any future well drilled to the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between 14,135' and 15,270' electric log measured depths (13,927' to 14,824' TVD) in the LLOG Exploration Company-SL 17599 No. 1 Well, located in Township 15 South, Range 13 East, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
