Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Legacy Resources Co., L.P. to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, pertaining to the following matters relative to the Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir J and Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir L in the Bayou Sale Field, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana:

ROBULUS 6 SAND, RESERVOIR J

1. To dissolve the reservoirwide unit created by Office of Conservation Order 87-G-8, effective December 1, 1968, as revised by Supplement to Office of Conservation Order 87-G-8, effective August 16, 1972, and to simultaneously, create a drilling and production unit for the Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir J, designated as the ROB 6 RJ SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto, with the same reservoir boundaries as the reservoirwide unit being dissolved;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created on an acre foot basis of participation as shown on the attached plat and exhibit;
3. To designate the Legacy-Wooster B No. 4 Well (SL 229903) as the unit well for the unit so created, and to designate the Legacy-Wooster B No. 1 Well (SL 225376) as an alternate unit well for said unit.

4. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation;
5. To continue in effect all provisions of prior orders relating to the ROB 6 Reservoir J in effect, to the extent that they are not in conflict with the above, including, but not limited to the waiver of the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir J.

The Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir J, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 87-G, effective June 1, 1961.

ROBULUS 6 SAND, RESERVOIR L

1. To dissolve the reservoirwide unit created by Office of Conservation Order 87-G-7, effective August 1, 1967, as revised by Supplement to Office of Conservation Order 87-G-7, effective September 29, 1967, and to simultaneously, create a drilling and production unit for the Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir L, designated as the ROB 6 RL SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto, with the same reservoir boundaries as the reservoirwide unit being dissolved, as;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, utilizing the formula for the current basis of participation in the existing reservoirwide unit for the ROB 6 RL SU adopted as "The Seventh Revised Exhibit C" by Office of Conservation Order 87-G-12, effective October 22, 1974, as shown on the attached plat and exhibit;
3. To designate the Legacy R D Gates No. 2 Well (SL 73803) as the unit well for the unit so created, and the Legacy-Wooster B No. 42 (SL173788) and the Legacy-Miami Corporation E No. 1 (undrilled) Wells as alternate unit wells for said unit;
4. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a

public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation;

5. To continue in effect all provisions of prior orders relating to the ROB 6 Reservoir L in effect, to the extent that they are not in conflict with the above, including, but not limited to the waiver of the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E;
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir L.

The Robulus 6 Sand, Reservoir L, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 87-G, effective June 1, 1961.

A pre-application conference was scheduled for January 12, 2006 but was not requested, and consequently was not held therefore we are proceeding with our application.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are the plats delineating the ROB 6 RJ SUA and ROB 6 RL SUA, showing the location of the proposed substitute unit well, together with a list of the names and addresses of all interested owners, interested parties and represented parties known to the applicant after a reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all such parties. A copy of said list is not being mailed to the interested owners, interested parties and represented parties, but will be provided upon request.
