LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, MARCH 1, 2006**, upon the application of **COMSTOCK OIL & GAS - LOUISIANA, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A and the Hosston A thru D, E-1 and E-2 Zones, Reservoirs A and C**, in the Cheniere Creek Field, Ouachita Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create three (3) additional drilling and production units (to be designated as CV RA SUK thru CV RA SUM) for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To redefine the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar AS the proposed CV RA SUK thru CV RA SUM are concerned, as that gas and condensate bearing interval between the depths of 9480 feet and 13,010 feet (electric log measurements) in the O'Brien Operating Company (Diamond Shamrock) - V German No. 1 Well, located in Section 25, Township 17 North, Range 1 East, Ouachita Parish, Louisiana.
4. To grant such exceptions as are necessary to Office of Conservation Order No. 503-J, effective November 22, 1983, and to authorize the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize the unit wells for the proposed units which are shown on the plat submitted with the application.
5. To designate Comstock Oil & Gas - Louisiana, LLC, as unit operator of the proposed units.
6. To authorize the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for HOSS A thru E-2 RA SUF, at the location shown on the plats submitted with the application.
7. To authorize the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for HOSS A thru C RC SUC and HOSS E-2 RC SUC, and a unit well for HOSS D RC SUC and HOSS E-1 RC SUC, as shown on the plats submitted with the application.
8. To authorize the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for HOSS A thru D RA SUC and HOSS E-2 RA SUC, and an alternate unit well for HOSS E-1 RA SUC, as shown on the plats submitted with the application.
9. To grant such exceptions as are necessary to the Office of Conservation Order No. 503-B Series of Orders, and particularly, Order No. 503-B-9, effective February 1, 1975, and Order No. 503-B-23, effective March 30, 1983, with respect to drilling the abovesaid substitute and alternate unit wells for the Hosston A thru D, E-1 and E-2 Zones, Reservoirs A and C.
10. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 503-J, effective November 22, 1983, but shall be redefined as set forth hereinabove, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar AS the proposed units are concerned.

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The Hosston A thru D Zones, Reservoir A, are defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 503, effective May 19, 1960.

The Hosston E-1 and E-2 Zones, Reservoir A, are defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 503-B-9, effective February 1, 1975.

The Hosston A thru E-2 Zones, Reservoir C, are defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 503-B-29, effective August 3, 1984.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Monroe**, Louisiana.
