

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 14, 2006**, upon the application of **HASSIE HUNT EXPLORATION COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Tex L-5 Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Lake Raccourci Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a single drilling and production unit, as shown on the plat submitted with the application, for the Tex L-5 Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with allocation of production from the unit well to the tracts within the unit to be on the basis of surface acreage.
3. To designate Hassie Hunt Exploration Company as the operator of Tex L-5 RA SUA to be created hereby.
4. To designate the Hassie Hunt Exploration Company SL 4534 LL&E No. 1 Well (Serial No. 226016), at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, as the unit well for the proposed Tex L-5 RA SUA.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Tex L-5 Sand, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the electric log measured depths of 11,242 feet (11,048' TVD) and 11,276 feet (11,072' TVD) in the Hassie Hunt Exploration Company - SL 4534 LL&E No. 1 Well, the surface location of which is in Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 21 East, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, with the bottom hole location being the SE/4 of Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 21 East, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
