**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 14, 2006**, upon the application of **BROWNING OIL COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **11,000' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Sullivans Lake Field, Iberville Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 11,000' Sand, Reservoir A, in Sullivans Lake Field, Iberville Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit designated 11000 RA SUA, as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Browning Oil Company, Inc. as operator of the proposed unit.
4. To designate its Schwing No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the 11,000' Sand, Reservoir A, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 11,000' Sand, Reservoir A, in the Sullivans Lake Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 11,552 feet and 11,644 feet (electrical log measurements) (subsea depths of 10,918 and 10,994 feet) in the Browning Oil Company, Inc. - Schwing No. 1 Well, located in Section 73, Township 10 South, Range 11 East, Iberville Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
