

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 23, 2006**, upon the application of **ORACLE OPERATING CO., LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Sabine Chalk Series, Reservoir A**, in the Ft. Jessup Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve eight (8) 20 acre units established by Office of Conservation Order No. 632, effective July 1, 1963, from the Sabine Chalk Series, Reservoir A, and to simultaneously create four (4) 40 +/- acre units for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Sabine Chalk Series, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract to share in the unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Oracle Operating Co., LLC as the operator of the proposed SAB SUFF.
4. To designate the Oracle Operating Co., LLC - Boyens No. 2 Well as the unit well for the proposed SAB SUFF.
5. To permit the Applicant to drill 200 +/- foot horizontal laterals from the vertical wells in each of the proposed units.
6. Except to the extent herewith, the provisions of the 632 Series of Office of Conservation Orders shall apply to the unit being requested to be created herewith.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Sabine Chalk Series, Reservoir A, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 632, effective July 1, 1963.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
