

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 23, 2006**, upon the application of **KILRUSH PETROLEUM, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Marg Tex Zone, Reservoir B, SUA, SUB and SUC**, in the Edgerly Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Marg Tex Zone, Reservoir B, SUA, SUB and SUC.
2. To create three (3) drilling and production units for this zone and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the units so created.
4. To provide that any wells drilled outside of the Marg Tex Zone, Reservoir B, SUA, SUB and SUC shall be in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Marg Tex Zone, Reservoir B, is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 7728' and 7850' (electrical log measurements) in the People's Energy Production-Texas L.P. - North American Land Company No. 3 Well (SN 228844), located in Section 33, Township 9 South, Range 11 West, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
