

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 23, 2006**, upon the application of **NADEL & GUSSMAN - JETTA OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hall Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish one (1) drilling and production unit for the exploration for and the production of gas and condensate for the Hall Sand, Reservoir A, such unit being designated HALL RA SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract to share in the unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Nadel & Gussman - Jetta Operating Company as the unit operator for the proposed HALL RA SUA and their Colvin D No. 1 Well as the unit well.
4. To provide that future wells drilled to the Hall Sand, Reservoir A, should be located at least 330 feet from unit lines and 2,000 feet between wells.
5. To provide for the reclassification of the reservoir without the necessity of a public hearing providing that sufficient data is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation to warrant a change.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hall Sand, Reservoir A, is to be defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 9,230 feet and 9,247 feet (electric log measurements) in the Nadel & Gussman - Jetta Operating Company (formerly Texas Oil & Gas Corporation) - Colvin D No. 1 Well, located in Section 7, Township 18 North, Range 2 West, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
