Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. for the calling of a public hearing, after ten days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters regarding the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a drilling and production units were created by the Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1977, and further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977.

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-W. F. Johnson Miller No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for the HOSS RA SU 73, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as the operator of the HOSS RA SU 73;
3. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the HOSS RA SU 73 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit;
4. To grant a single unit allowable for the HOSS RA SU 73 and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowable from the unit well, or the proposed alternate unit well, or from either of the wells at its option;

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5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 289, as amended and supplemented by the 289 Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect;
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the sand and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of each reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation, and
7. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1977 and further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the HOSS RA SU 73, showing the location of the alternate unit well together with a list of the names and addresses of all interested owners, interested parties and represented parties who are known to the applicant after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all such parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, interested parties and represented parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any of these parties desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.


