LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 15, 2006**, upon the application of **DUNCAN OIL, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Miocene Zone, Reservoir A and the Marg Zone Reservoir A**, in the Louisiana Point Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Marg Zone, Reservoir A.
3. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said units.
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Miocene Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 9,240 feet and 10,053 feet (electrical log measurements) in the J. S. Abercrombie Mineral Corporation - Pan Am Fee No. 2 Well (SN 123605), located in Section 26, Township 15 South, Range 15 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

The Marg Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 10,750 feet and 12,350 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Phillips Petroleum Company - State Lease 12099 No. 1 Well (SN 207370), located in Township 14 South, Range 15 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
