**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2006**, upon the application of **SWIFT ENERGY OPERATING, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Wilcox Zone, Reservoir A**, in the South Bearhead Creek Field, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the L WX RA SU previously created by Office of Conservation Order No. 439-B-1, effective April 23, 1991, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised L WX RA SU for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the South Bearhead Creek Field, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana.
2. To redefine the Lower Wilcox Zone, Reservoir A, as being that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,470 feet and 14,100 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Swift Energy Operating, LLC-Krause and Managan Lumber No. 1 Well, located in Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 11 West, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed revised reservoirwide unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To continue Swift Energy Operating, LLC, as unit operator and to grant it permission to designate and utilize its Krause & Managan Lumber Co. No. 1 Well as an additional unit well for the proposed revised reservoirwide unit.
5. Except to the extent herein provided, to extend the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 439-B-1 as amended and supplemented, and all applicable Statewide Orders to the proposed revised reservoirwide unit.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Wilcox Zone, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 439-B-1, effective April 23, 1991, and is hereby redefined as set forth at Item No. 2 above.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
