Application is hereby made on behalf of Harbour Resources, LLC for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the above captioned sands and reservoirs, in the Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana:

M' SAND, RESERVOIR A

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the M' Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana;
2. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 105 acres and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation;
3. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing, should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner.
4. To consider any other matters which may be pertinent to this application.

The M' Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand between the measured depths of 11,582 and 11,643 feet (electric log measurements) in the James A. Whitson,

Jr. – Libby Ayo et al #1 well, located in Section 56, Township 15 South, Range 18 East, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

### M-1 SAND, RESERVOIR B

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the M-1 Sand, Reservoir B, in the Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana;
2. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 151 acres and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation;
3. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing, should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner.
4. To consider any other matters which may be pertinent to this application.

The M-1 Sand, Reservoir B, in the Lake Boeuf Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand between the measured depths of 11,962 and 11,974 feet (electric log measurements) in the James A. Whitson, Jr. – Libby Ayo et al #1 well, located in Section 56, Township 15 South, Range 18 East, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed application was held at 10:30 a.m. on July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2007 at the offices of W. H. Robbins & Associates, LLC, 302 La Rue France, Suite 100, Lafayette, LA 70508. A list of parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. The conference was opened by Mr. Bill Dale for the applicant who explained the basis for the unit being requested. Questions were asked and answered. It is not anticipated that there will be opposition at the public hearing on this matter.
