**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 27, 2007**, upon the application of **RED WILLOW OFFSHORE, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **T Sand, Reservoir B**, in the Kings Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the T Sand, Reservoir B.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each separate tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To extend to the proposed T RB SUB, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 638-Q, effective January 25, 1978, as amended by Order No. 638-Q-1, effective September 27, 2006, and applicable Statewide Orders.
4. To confirm and continue in effect the existing unit for the T Sand, Reservoir B, as created by Order No. 638-Q-1, effective September 27, 2006.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The T Sand, Reservoir B, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 638-Q, effective January 25, 1978, and is hereby further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 14,050' and 14,336' (electrical log measurements) in the Red Willow Offshore, LLC-Sanders No. 1 Well, located in Section 22, Township 14 South, Range 7 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
