

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 24, 2007**, upon the application of **NADEL & GUSSMAN-JETTA OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Dixie Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create eleven (11) drilling and production units for the exploration of and the production of gas and condensate for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property within the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract to share in the unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator and unit well where applicable.
4. To require future wells drilled to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, to be located at least 660 feet from unit lines and 1320 feet between wells.
5. To provide for reclassification of the reservoir if the producing characteristics should change without the necessity of a public hearing, if evidence is presented to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation to warrant such change.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, is to be defined as that gas and condensate productive interval encountered between the depths of 7,804' to 9,040' (electric log measurements) in the Nadel & Gussman - Jetta Operating Company - Franks 17 No. 1 Well located in Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 14 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
