LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 24, 2007**, upon the application of **GOODRICH PETROLEUM COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU52, SU73 and SU77 and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU67, SU78 and SU80**, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana.

HOSSTON FORMATION, RESERVOIR A, SU52, SU73 AND SU77

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Champe Graham No. 4 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the HOSS RA SU52 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') feet from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Johnson No. 2 Well and the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Champe Graham No. 2 Well as additional alternate unit wells for the HOSS RA SU73 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') feet from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Taylor No. 3 Well as an alternate unit well for the HOSS RA SU77 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') feet from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the HOSS RA SU52, HOSS RA SU73 and HOSS RA SU77 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within each unit.
5. To grant a single unit allowable for the HOSS RA SU52, HOSS RA SU73 and HOSS RA SU77 and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit wells, the alternate unit wells, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option.
6. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC as operator of the HOSS RA SU52, HOSS RA SU73 and HOSS RA SU77.
7. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.

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8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 and was further defined in Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977.

COTTON VALLEY FORMATION, RESERVOIR A, SU67, SU78, AND SU80

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Taylor No. 3 Well as an additional alternate unit well for CV RA SU67, such well to be at the location shown on the plats submitted with the application.
2. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Champe Graham No. 2 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU67 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974 as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Johnson No. 2 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU78 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') feet from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974 as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC-Champe Graham No. 4 Well as an alternate unit well for the CV RA SU80 at the exceptional location or no closer than one hundred (100') feet from the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
5. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the CV RA SU67, CV RA SU78 and CV RA SU80 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within each unit.
6. To grant a single unit allowable for the CV RA SU67, CV RA SU78 and CV RA SU80 and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit wells, the alternate unit wells, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option.
7. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC as operator of the CV RA SU67, CV RA SU78 and CV RA SU80.
8. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, and further defined in Order No. 289-J-1, effective April 14, 1977.
