

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 23, 2007**, upon the application of **SAMSON CONTOUR ENERGY E&P LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hayes Sand, Reservoir E**, in the Ellis Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Hayes Sand, Reservoir E.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Hayes Sand, Reservoir E and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that the Hayes Sand, Reservoir E, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and that any wells drilled outside of the Hayes Sand, Reservoir E should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hayes Sand, Reservoir E, is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between 10,338' and 10,390' electric log measured depths (10,272' and 10,324' TVD) in the Samson Contour Energy E&P, LLC-Loretta Young No. 1 Well (SN 233018), located in Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
