**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, MAY 30, 2007**, upon the application of **JUSTISS OIL COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Wilcox A and B Zones, Reservoir A**, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and create drilling and production units for the Wilcox A and B Zones, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed sand units with the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and property interests to share in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate the proposed Justiss Oil Company Placid Fee MA No. 5 as the unit well for proposed Wilcox A RA SUN and Wilcox B RA SUN, and to designate Justiss Oil Company as unit operator of Wilcox A RA SUN and Wilcox B RA SUN.
4. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1106-A so as to permit the drilling of the Justiss Oil Company, Inc. Placid Fee MA No. 5 Well at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application and to determine that the proposed location will effectively and efficiently drain portions of the reservoir which would not otherwise be drained by the existing wellbore in WX A RA SUN absent the approval of the exceptional location.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, was fully and completely defined by Office of Conservation Order No. 1106-A as that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 1,893' and 2,690' (electric log measurements) in the Hunt Petroleum Corporation-IPB LLS No. 69 Well, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East.

The Wilcox B Zone, Reservoir A, as used herein, is defined as that oil and gas or gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 2,690' and 2,875' (electric log measurements) in the Hunt Petroleum Corporation-IPB LLS No. 69 Well, located in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 2 East.
