

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 26, 2007**, upon the application of **CLAYTON WILLIAMS ENERGY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Gray Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Sugar Creek Field, Lincoln and Claiborne Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To permit the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a unit well for GRAY RA SUB, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, in exception to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 23-R, effective January 23, 1981.
2. To explicitly find that the proposed unit well is necessary to drain a portion of the Gray Sand, Reservoir A, underlying GRAY RA SUB, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well in such unit.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Gray Sand, Reservoir A, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 23-R, effective January 23, 1981.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
