LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JULY 17, 2007**, upon the application of **GOODRICH PETROLEUM COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU88 and SU49 and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU80 and SU92**, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

HOSSTON FORMATION, RESERVOIR A, SU88

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company-Thomas No. 3 Well as an alternate well for the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU88, within fifty feet (50') of the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, but no closer than three hundred thirty feet (330') from the unit boundary shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the HOSS RA SU88 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the HOSS RA SU88 and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or from any combination at its option.
4. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company as operator of the HOSS RA SU88.
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

HOSSTON FORMATION, RESERVOIR A, SU49

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company-Talbert No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU49, within fifty feet (50') of the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, but no closer than three hundred thirty feet (330') from the unit boundary shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954 and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 13, 1977.

BETHANY-LONGSTREET FIELD

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COTTON VALLEY FORMATION, RESERVOIR A, SU80 AND SU92

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC, to designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company-Champe Graham No. 5 Well as an alternate well for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU80, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974 as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders and to permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC to designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company-Talbert No. 1 and Thomas No. 3 Wells as alternate wells for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU92, within fifty feet (50') of the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, but no closer than three hundred thirty feet (330') from the unit boundary shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the CV RA SU80 and CV RA SU92 which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit.
4. To grant a single unit allowable for the CV RA SU80 and CV RA SU92 and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option.
5. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company as operator of the CV RA SU80 and CV RA SU92.
6. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders.
