LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.
In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 14, 2007**, upon the application of **EOG RESOURCES, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **McCreary Sand, Reservoir A; the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir C; and the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B**, in the East Dykesville Field, Webster and Claiborne Parishes, Louisiana.

MCCREARY SAND, RESERVOIR A

1. To dissolve the units designated McC RA SUC and McC RA SUD, created for the McCreary Sand, Reservoir A, by Office of Conservation Order No. 882, effective October 18, 1971.

The McCreary Sand, Reservoir A, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 882, effective October 5, 1971.

COTTON VALLEY ZONE, RESERVOIR C AND HAYNESVILLE ZONE, RESERVOIR B

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from each of these zones and reservoirs.
2. To create thirteen (13) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir C.
3. To create twelve (12) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B.
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To designate an operator of, and unit well for, any of the proposed units as may be appropriate.
6. To provide that future wells drilled to these zones, within or outside of the units proposed herein, be located no closer than 330 feet to any unit boundary and no closer than 1,000 feet to any well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to these zones.
7. To permit applicant to combine downhole production from the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir C, with production from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, in units for those zones which are identical in areal extent and in wells drilled thereon in which the interests of all parties in such units are identical.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

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The Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir C, is defined as that interval encountered between the measured depths of 7,930' and 10,025' in the Wheless Industries-Pelto Oil-Harp No. 1 Well, located in Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 8 West, less and except the McCreary Sand, Reservoir A, as defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 882, effective October 5, 1971, INSO FAR AND ONLY INSO FAR as to proposed units CV RC SUF and CV RC SUK.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, is defined as that interval encountered between the measured depths of 10,025' and 12,090' in the Wheless Industries-Pelto Oil-Harp No. 1 Well, located in Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 8 West, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
