

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 7, 2007**, upon the application of **CAMEX OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **6,100' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize its M. Leger A-1 Well as a substitute unit well for the 6100 RA SUA, said well located as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that this well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the unit which cannot be so drained by any existing well within such unit.
3. To designate the existing unit well, the Camex Operating Company - M. Leger A-2 Well, as an alternate unit well for the 6100 RA SUA, said well located as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To permit the operator to produce the unit allowable from the proposed substitute unit well and/or the proposed alternate unit well in any combination at the discretion of the operator.
5. To grant whatever spacing exceptions are necessary with respect to the abovementioned wells.
6. Except to the extent herein set forth, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 544-AA, effective April 1, 1981, and the unit created thereby.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 6,100' Sand, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 544-AA, effective April 1, 1981.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
