

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA. In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 21, 2007**, upon the application of **DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION COMPANY, LP.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Causey Sand, Reservoir A; the Upper Hosston Zone; the Hosston 6,700' Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston 6,932' Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston 6,975' Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston 7,900' Zone, Reservoir A; the Hosston 8100' Zone, Reservoir A; and the Vaughn Sand**, in the Ruston Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Devon Energy Production Company, LP to designate and utilize the wells identified at the locations shown on the plats submitted with the application, two (2) alternate unit wells for CAUSEY RA SUC; three (3) alternate unit wells for U HOSS SUG; two (2) alternate unit wells for HOSS 6700 RA SUE; two (2) alternate unit wells for HOSS 6932 RA SUE; one (1) alternate unit well for HOSS 6975 RA SUE; one (1) alternate unit well for HOSS 7850 RA SUE; two (2) alternate unit wells for HOSS 7900 RA SUE; one (1) alternate unit well for HOSS 8100 RA SUE; and one (1) alternate unit well for VGN SUO.
2. To approve as exceptions to the location provisions of applicable orders such of the wells that are the subject of this application which do not comply with the well spacing provisions of said orders.
3. To specifically recognize and approve the Devon Energy Production Company, LP-JB Giles 19 No. 1 Well, which is a directionally drilled well with a surface location of 624' FSL and 2466' FEL and a bottom hole location of 549' FSL and 1729' FEL of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 2 West, as an alternate unit well at an exceptional location for CAUSEY RA SUC; U HOSS SUG; HOSS 6700 SUE; HOSS 6932 SUE; HOSS 6975 SUE; HOSS 7850 SUE; HOSS 7900 SUE; HOSS 8100 SUE; and VGN SUO.
4. To establish that each of the above wells is necessary to efficiently and effectively recover additional hydrocarbons underlying the units on which they are to be located.
5. To authorize the unit allowable for each of these units to be recovered from the existing wells on these respective units where applicable, the proposed wells, or from any combination of the wells located on said units, at the discretion of the operator.
6. To authorize the down hole or well bore combination of hydrocarbons from any current or future wells drilled to any of the sands or zones on the units which are the subject of this application provided that the units for such sands or zones are of the same size and configuration and the ownership within them is the same.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Upper Hosston Zone was defined in Office of Conservation Order No.164-O, effective September 1, 1964.

The Hosston 6,700' Zone, Reservoir A, the Hosston 6,932' Zone, Reservoir A and the Hosston 6,975' Zone, Reservoir A, were defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 164-O-27, effective May 18, 1993.

The Hosston 7,850' Zone, Reservoir A, the Hosston 7,900' Zone, Reservoir A, and the Hosston 8,100' Zone, Reservoir A, were defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 164-O-29, effective January 10, 1995.

The Vaughn Sand was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 164, effective March 31, 1949.
