INDIGO MINERALS LLC ("Applicant") hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, such unit being shown on the attached plat and being designated HA RB SUL.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed additional unit in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator of, and unit well for, the proposed additional unit as may be appropriate.
4. To propose that future wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone within or outside of the unit proposed herein be located no closer than 330 feet to any unit boundary and no closer than 660 feet to any well completed in, drilling to, or for which a permit has been granted to drill to the Haynesville Zone.
5. To expand the provisions of the previous Order issued by the Office of Conservation authorizing downhole combination of production from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, underlying HOSS RA SU36, and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, underlying CV RA SU102, which units are identical to the additional unit proposed herein for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, so as to include production from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, in any well in which the interests in the units from which production is to be combined downhole are identical.
6. To define the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, as to the additional unit proposed herein, as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 10,260 feet and 11,860 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Bidas Energy USA, Inc.--David Mason 27 No. 1 Well, located in Section 27, Township 13 North, Range 15 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B.

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The initial unitization for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field is the subject of the application of Beusa Energy, Inc., under Docket No. 08-563, the public hearing on which was held on April 29, 2008.



A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.

By letter dated May 19, 2008, Applicant gave notice, in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure, of its intention to apply for a public hearing concerning these proposals and set June 11, 2008, as the tentative date for the pre-application conference. No request for the conference was received within ten (10) days after the date of said letter; therefore, no pre-application conference will be held. Applicant has revised its proposals from those set out in the Pre-Application Notice to request that the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, be redefined as to the proposed additional unit in the manner set forth above. Should any party desire to discuss such redefinition, they should call the undersigned at (318) 429-7200.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of the unit plat showing the unit proposed to be created (which is identical to the plat attached to the pre-application notice) is enclosed herewith, and a copy of this letter and of the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plat, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Bethany-Longstreet Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, enclosed herewith is our check payable to the Office of Conservation covering the application fee.
