TMR EXPLORATION, INC. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, and to the Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, in the Jamestown Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize an additional alternate unit well for HOSS A RA SUN and for HOSS B RA SUN at the location shown on the attached plat.
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, and Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, underlying HOSS A&B RA SUN which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on these units.
3. To permit the operator of HOSS A RA SUN and of HOSS B RA SUN to produce the allowables assigned to those units from either the unit well, from any alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the option of the operator.
4. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, in Jamestown Field, Bienville and Webster Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 999-B, effective November 27, 1990. The Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, in Jamestown Field, Bienville and Webster

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Parishes, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 999-C, effective November 27, 1990.



As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Pursuant to the aforesaid Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of this letter and of the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties, as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Jamestown Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the application fee is enclosed.
