Application is hereby made on behalf of **LIBERTY RESOURCES, INC.** for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Sparta Sand, Reservoir B**, in the **Livonia Field**, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To redefine the Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 420-G, effective February 12, 2008, as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,716 feet and 10,811 feet, electrical log measurements, in the Liberty Resources, Inc. – Beauvais No. 1 Well, located in Section 119, Township 6 South, Range 9 East, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana;
2. To confirm and continue in force and effect the exterior boundaries of the existing SP RB SUA, created by Office of Conservation No. 420-G, for this redefined interval;

3. To confirm the Liberty Resources, Inc. - Beauvais No. 1 Well as the unit well for SP RB SUA;
4. To confirm Liberty Resources, Inc. as the operator for SP RB SUA ;
5. To confirm and continue in force and effect, except to the extent they are inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 420-G; and
6. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, in the Livonia Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 420-G, effective February 12, 2008, and is hereby redefined as provided in numbered paragraph 1 hereof.

The proposed redefinition would not change any owner's unit share of the existing unit. The proposed redefinition would expand the existing definition for the Sparta Sand, Reservoir B, by revising the base of the sand definition to a deeper depth; it would make no change to the top of the existing definition. The applicant recompleted the unit well at a depth deeper than that included in the definition of SP RB SUA provided in Order 420-G. The purpose of this application is to include such deeper depths within the definition of SP RB SUA.

The pre-application conference tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, June 27, 2008, WILL NOT BE HELD, as it was not requested within the delays provided for by the Rules of Procedure; therefore, no opposition to this Application at the hearing is anticipated.

However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, enclosed herein is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation in payment of the required hearing application fee.
