Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **PETROGULF CORPORATION** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the MA-1 Sand, Reservoir C, in Patterson Field, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated MA-1 RC SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each separate tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To designate Petrogulf Corporation as operator of the proposed unit.
4. To designate its Shadyside No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit at the location shown on the plat attached hereto.
5. To provide that any future substitute and/or alternate unit wells drilled to the MA-1 Sand, Reservoir C, should be exempt from the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the MA-1 Sand, Reservoir C, in Patterson Field, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The MA-1 Sand, Reservoir C, in Patterson Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 16,400 feet and 16,630 feet (electrical log measurements) (16,354 feet and 16,559 feet – true vertical depths) in the Petrogulf Corporation - Shadyside No. 1 Well located in Section 58, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana.

Any pertinent data, including well logs not available from the Office of Conservation, may be obtained AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY from Frank W. Harrison, Jr., P. O. Box 51943, Lafayette, LA 70505, Telephone No. (337)232-4031. The proposed unit has been slightly modified since the pre-application was mailed out. The undersigned should be notified should anyone wish to consult regarding this minor modification.






