Dear Commissioner Welsh:

By letter dated June 30, 2008 (the "Application"), **SANDRIDGE EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION, L.L.C.** made application to your office for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order which would permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize an alternate well for the unit designated WX B RA SUM for the Wilcox B Sand, Reservoir A, in the Cowards Gully Field. Pursuant to Rule 9 of the Revised Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings before the Commissioner of Conservation, **SANDRIDGE EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION, L.L.C.** hereby amends the Application to read as follows:

1. *To permit the applicant, Sandridge Exploration and Production, L.L.C., to drill, designate and utilize an alternate well for the unit designated WX B RA SUM at the location shown on the plat attached hereto, which is an exception to the spacing provisions of the Office of Conservation Order No. 1222, effective January 26, 1983, with an as-drilled tolerance of no closer than fifty (50') feet to the western unit line;*


2. *To authorize the operator of WX B RA SUM to produce the unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit well, or both, at its discretion; and*

This revision changes only the nomenclature from WX B RA SUA to WX B RA SUM for the proposed alternate well unit in the Application.

In all other respects the Application shall remain the same, and to the extent necessary, the Application is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof a list of the names and addresses of the parties to whom this revised unitization proposal is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it, at the cost of the requesting party. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.


