Application is hereby made on behalf of **MAYNE & MERTZ, INC.** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize its Broussard Farms No. 2 Well as alternate unit well for the L HBY RG SUA, at the location shown on the plat attached hereto, in accordance with to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1098-B-5, effective March 30, 2005.
2. To permit the operator to produce the unit allowable from the existing unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or both, at its option.
3. To find that the aforementioned well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the subject unit which cannot be so drained by any existing well within said unit.
4. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1098-B-5, effective March 30, 2005, and the L HBY RG SUA created thereby.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Hackberry Sand, in the Pine Ridge Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1098-B, effective September 7, 1983, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1098-B-3, effective December 20, 1988.




