APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Will-Drill Production Co., Inc. Hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Hosston Zone and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Will-Drill Production Co., Inc. to drill, designate and utilize the Whitten 7 No. 1 Well and Luedtke 7 No. 1 Well as alternate unit wells on HOSS SU56 and CV RA SUT at the exceptional locations shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To authorize Will-Drill Production Co., Inc. to designate and utilize the Humphries No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well on HOSS SU56 at the exceptional location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
3. To establish that the proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to efficiently and economically drain portions of the Hosston Zone underlying HOSS SU54 and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, underlying CV RA SUT which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such units;
4. To authorize the unit allowable for HOSS SU54 and CV RA SUT to be recovered from the existing wells on these units, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator; and

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5. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Hosston Zone in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 28-S, effective April 21, 1970.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Logansport Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 28-W-1, effective October 15, 1982.
