Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **The Louisiana Land & Exploration Company** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters regarding the 78 Zone, Reservoir F, Four Isle Dome Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a drilling and production unit was created by the Office of Conservation Order No. 495-W-5, effective March 2, 1999.

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 495-W-5 and Statewide Order No. 29-E and to permit applicant, The Louisiana Land & Exploration Company to drill, designate and utilize the The Louisiana Land & Exploration Company-LL&E ST UA No. 1 Well (ST-2) as a substitute unit well for the 78 RF SUA, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Louisiana Land & Exploration Company-LL&E ST UA No. 1 Well (ST-2) is less than 330 feet from the nearest unit boundary.
2. This well is necessary because the present unit well, the LL&E ST UA No. 1 Well, had mechanical problems and never produced from the 78 Zone.
3. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 495-W-5, shall remain in full force and effect, and

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4. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.

The 78 Zone, Reservoir F, Four Isle Dome Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 495-W-5, effective March 2, 1999.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the 78 RF SUA showing the location of the substitute unit well together with a list of the names and addresses of all interested owners, interested parties and represented parties who are known to the applicant after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all such parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, interested parties and represented parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any of these parties desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.


