CORONADO ENERGY E&P COMPANY, L.L.C. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, and to the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize two (2) additional alternate unit wells for HOSS RA SUA, three (3) additional alternate unit wells for HOSS RA SU2, seven (7) additional alternate unit wells for HOSS RA SU4, three (3) alternate unit wells for HOSS RA SU5, one (1) additional alternate unit well for HOSS RA SU46 and one (1) additional alternate unit well for HOSS RA SU6, at the locations shown on an attached plat, and to approve exceptions to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-3, effective October 7, 1977, and Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-5, effective November 1, 1978, for the location of any of these proposed wells which does not comply with the spacing provisions of these Orders.
2. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) additional alternate unit wells for CV RA SU75, seven (7) additional alternate unit wells for CV RA SU76, five (5) alternate unit wells for CV RA SU101, two (2) alternate unit wells for CV RA SU104 and one (1) alternate unit well for CV RA SU105, at the locations shown on an attached plat, and to approve exceptions to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, for the location of any of these proposed wells which does not comply with the spacing provisions of this Order.
3. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a horizontal well as a substitute unit well for CV RA SU96 at the location shown on an attached plat, and to approve an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, for all productive portions of the wellbore of this well located at least 330 feet from a unit boundary.
4. To find that each of the proposed substitute and alternate unit wells is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the hydrocarbons underlying the unit on which it is proposed to be drilled which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such unit.
5. To permit the operator of the units on which these substitute and alternate unit wells are proposed to be drilled to produce the allowables assigned to these units from either the unit or substitute unit well, from any alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the option of the operator.

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6. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, and was further defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J-1, effective April 14, 1977.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 North Causeway Boulevard, Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person wishing to inspect any such data should call Mr. Louis Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.

As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Pursuant to the aforesaid Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of this letter, and of each of the attached plats, is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to each of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plats, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Bethany-Longstreet Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, enclosed herewith is our check payable to the Office of Conservation covering the application fee.




