Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **FORZA OPERATING, LLC**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Parcerdue Field, Lafayette and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Parcerdue Field, Lafayette and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana, said proposed unit to be designated 14700 RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901, et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E);
4. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A.


The 14,700' Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Parcerdue Field, Lafayette and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,960 feet and 16,420 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Nexen Petroleum U.S.A. (Stone Oil Corporation) – M. Broussard No. 1 Well, located in Section 54, Township 11 South, Range 4 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, pre-application notice was given; however, no request for the conference was received. Therefore, the conference tentatively scheduled for July 24, 2008, **WILL NOT BE HELD.**


