Re: Gyrodina Zone, Reservoir A  
Lighthouse Point Field  
Vermilion Parish, Louisiana

Application is hereby made on behalf of **EL PASO E&P COMPANY, L.P.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Gyrodina Zone, Reservoir A, in the Lighthouse Point Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated GYR RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Gyrodina Zone, Reservoir A, in Lighthouse Point Field, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Gyrodina Zone, Reservoir A, in the Lighthouse Point Field, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Gyrodina Zone, Reservoir A, in Lighthouse Point Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 14,720 feet and 16,370 feet (electrical log measured depths) in the Quintana Petroleum

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Corporation – State Lease 340 No. 3 Well, located in South Marsh Island Block 290, Lighthouse Point Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, and is further defined with a top of 14,880 feet (electrical log measured depth) in the Quintana Petroleum Corporation – State Lease 340 No. 1 Well OH, located in South Marsh Island Block 290, Lighthouse Point Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.



A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.


