

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 16, 2008**, upon the application of **CEL PROPERTIES, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **FJ Sand, Reservoir C, Marginulina Tex Sand, Reservoir D and Marginulina Tex Zone, Reservoir H**, in the Maurice Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the existing drilling and production unit created as the FJ Sand, Reservoir C, by Office of Conservation Order No. 366-W-2, effective October 16, 1990.
2. To dissolve the existing drilling and production unit created as the Marg Tex Sand, Reservoir D, by Order No. 366-K-7, effective October 16, 1990.
3. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Marginulina Tex Zone, Reservoir H.
4. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit.
5. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Marginulina Tex Zone, Reservoir H, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone the top of which is encountered at a depth of 15,309' (electrical log measurement) in the Quintana Petroleum Corporation-Melancon No. 1 Well, located in Section 35, Township 10 South, Range 3 East and the base of which is found at a depth of 15,558' (electrical log measurement) in the Quintana Petroleum Corporation-Grubbs No. 1 Well, located in Section 41, Township 10 South, Range 3 East.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
