Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A and Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU52, SU73 and SU80

1. To drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.- Champe Graham No. 6 Well as an additional alternate unit well for HOSS RA SU52, such well to be at the location shown on the attached plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.- Johnson No. 4 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the HOSS RA SU73 and to grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954, as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders and to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company-Taylor No. 5 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the HOSS RA SU73, such wells to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
3. To drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-A. V. Loftus No. 1 Well as an additional alternate unit well for HOSS RA SU80, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached plat and made a part hereof;
4. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU 52, SU 73, and SU 80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field which cannot be efficiently and economically be drained by any other well within the units;
5. To grant a single unit allowable for the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU 52, SU 73, and SU 80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option;

6. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as operator of the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU52, SU73 and SU80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, such wells to be at the location shown on the plat attached plat and made a part hereof;
7. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 289, effective October 1, 1954, as amended and supplemented by the 289-A-g Series of Orders, shall remain in full force and effect;
8. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.
9. The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order no. 289, effective October 1, 1954 and was further defined in Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977.

Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU66, SU67, SU78 & SU80

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-A. V. Loftus No. 1 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU66, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-Taylor No. 5 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU67, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
3. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-Johnson No. 4 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU78 such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
4. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.-Champe Graham No. 6 Well as an additional alternate unit well for the CV RA SU80, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
5. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU 66, SU 67, SU 78 and SU 80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field which cannot be efficiently and economically be drained by any other well within the units;
6. To grant a single unit allowable for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU 66, SU 67, SU 78 and SU 80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option;
7. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as operator of the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU 66, SU 67, SU 78 and SU 80 in the Bethany-Longstreet Field;
8. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, as amended and supplemented by the 289-J Series of Orders, shall remain in full force and effect;
9. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

10. The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, Bethany-Longstreet Field, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 1, 1974, and further defined in Order No. 289-J-1, effective April 14, 1977.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are plats outlining the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, SU52, SU73 and SU80 and Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, SU66, SU67, SU78 and SU80, Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom this notice is being sent. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.


