On behalf of QUESTAR EXPLORATION AND PRODUCTION COMPANY, application is hereby made for a public hearing to receive evidence concerning the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Upper Sligo Sand, Reservoir A, West Zone of the Sligo Formation, Hosston L Sand, and the Hosston Formation, in the Simsboro Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) additional alternate unit wells for U SLI RA SUB, WEST SUA, HOSS L SUA, and HOSS SUA, at the locations shown on the attached plat, in exception to the well spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 222, effective December 4, 1951, and Order No. 222-E, effective June 1, 1965;
2. To explicitly find that the proposed additional alternate unit wells are necessary to drain a portion of the abovesaid sands, zone, formation and reservoirs in the Simsboro Field underlying the respective units referenced above, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well in such units;
3. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Hosston L Sand, in the Simsboro Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, is fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 222, effective December 4, 1951.

The Hosston Formation, in the Simsboro Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, is fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 222-1, effective September 1, 1957.

The Rules of Procedure of the Commissioner of Conservation pertaining to the Pre-Application Notice requirements, are not applicable to the hearing requested herein, which requires legal notice of only ten (10) days.


